Researchers who intend to have chicken processed for human consumption are required to formally apply to the CFS for a research chicken allowance, and must also adhere to the Chicken Farmers of Canada's (CFC) On Farm Food Safety Program (OFFSP) and Animal Care Program (ACP).

Each project requires a separate application to be completed by the researcher.
