The Chicken Farmers of Saskatchewan (CFS) is supportive of research and development in the chicken industry, provided the activities follow the guidelines for humane animal care and use set out by the Canadian Council on Animal Care (CCAC), and any other applicable local or provincial body. Researchers who intend to have chicken processed for human consumption at the end of their study are required to formally apply to the CFS for a research chicken allowance, and must also adhere to the Chicken Farmers of Canada's (CFC) On Farm Food Safety Assurance Program (OFFSAP) and Animal Care Program (ACP).
