What is the SCIDF Industry Investment Program?

The SCIDF Industry Investment program (SIIP) was developed by the Saskatchewan Chicken Industry Development Fund (SCIDF) Committee and the Chicken Farmers of Saskatchewan (CFS) Board of Directors to reimburse Saskatchewan broiler chicken producers for their portion of qualified expenses claimed under Agri Food Canada's Poultry Egg Farm Investment Program (PEFIP). The SIIP is intended to provide support for licensed Saskatchewan broiler chicken farms making investments to increase efficiency, biosecurity, environmental sustainability and changing consumer preference. As our Saskatchewan farmers adapt to the new market realities of producing chicken, this program intends to be an additional form of industry support for the betterment of the industry.

The SIIP will fund the producer portion of **AAFC approved** expenditures for each project up to a maximum of 30% of the Funding Limit Associated with your license. This amount can be found in your Participant Dashboard under Participant License. Note this funding limit must be associated with your license listed under the Chicken Sector and is limited to the funding associated with the CPTPP and CUSMA trade agreements only. Any future funding additions to the PEFIP due to trade or other agreements will not be part of the SIIP top up program.

Each farmer who applies for the PEFIP will have an individual pre-approved contribution and payment ceiling based on their cost share ratio. This ceiling will be used to administer all SIIP claims and payments. **SIIP will not cover** all the unpaid portion of the project. Farmers will receive a letter stating their AAFC allotment along with the maximum SIIP payment based on the appropriate cost sharing ratio.

Who Qualifies for the SIIP?

To qualify for the SIIP, you must:

1. Be a Saskatchewan licensed, quota holding broiler chicken farmer;
2. Have applied and been approved for funding under the Agri-Food Canada PEFIP program; and
3. Have received funding payment(s) under the PEFIP program.

What do you Need to Apply?

The following information is necessary to apply for each claim submitted to the SIIP;

1. The "Claimed funding Sources" form – received from AAFC and submitted with payment of PEFIP fund rebate, this form indicates the funds approved for payment by AAFC, the approved producer contribution portion and the amount of PEFIP paid under the claim. A copy of the form is necessary for each claim.
2. Copy of "Participant Dashboard" from the PEFIP application website - farmers may have to take a screenshot of this dashboard. Information must include Farm Name, Producer license number, participant status, participant projects and payment status. (access code should not be included or be blacked out for confidential purposes).
3. A completed copy of the SIIP application form, located on the CFS website in the producer portal. The information on this form **MUST** co-incide with the information under your license number on the CFS Grower Portal and the PEFIP documents submitted.

Saskatchewan broiler chicken farmers may apply for the SIIP more than once, but total SIIP payments



will not exceed 30% of the Maximum PEFIP Funding Available for this Claim as shown in line "I" on the QL PEFIP Claimed Funding Sources document provided to farmers by AAFC.

Because the SIIP depends on approved costs for the PEFIP, no claims under the SIIP will be approved or paid until actual payments have been made to applicants under the PEFIP by AAFC. SIIP is considered industry support and should be noted on any future applications to the PEFIP program.

When can you apply for the SIIP?

Eligible producers may submit claims under the SIIP starting January 2, 2024. CFS anticipates a high volume of participation and claims under this program. As such, we have outlined submission deadlines and payment dates for 2024 and 2025:

Deadlines for SIIP applications and the expected payment dates for 2024 and 2025*:

Deadline #1

Submission by April 30, 2024 for payment in July 2024.

Deadline #2

Submission by September 30, 2024 for payment in December 2024.

Deadline #3

Submission by April 30, 2025 for payment in July 2025.

Deadline #4

Submission by September 30, 2025 for payment in December 2025.

*Please note that additional submission dates will be added after 2025 depending on status of PEFIP claims, volume of claims and program participation. The deadline for application to the PEFIP is March 31, 2030 with projects being completed by March 31, 2031. SIIP applications will be accepted until June 30, 2031 or as deemed necessary.

Producers should be aware that incorrect submissions to the SIIP will cause payments to be moved to the next submission/payment date or rejected, therefore we urge you to provide all information necessary to review and administer payments in a timely manner.

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•The SIIP depends on approved costs for the PEFIP, NO CLAIMS under SIIP will be assessed or approved until actual payment has been made to applicants under PEFIP by AAFC.

•The SIIP will fund the producer portion of AAFC approved expenditures for each project up to a maximum of 30% (or 15% for young farmers under 35 years of age) of allowable expenses under the PEFIP program. Each farmer who applies for the PEFIP will have an individual pre-approved contribution and payment ceiling. This ceiling will be used to administer all SIIP claims and payments.
