EFFECTIVE: February 17, 2019 (A-155 Production Cycle)

MINIMUM PRICE: \$1.5999/KG (live)

- The live minimum price for A-155 is a 2.28 ¢/kg increase from the A-154 live minimum price of \$1.5771/kg (live). The change in price is based on:
 - The Ontario posted minimum live price of \$1.550/kg for weight category 'Over 2.45kg to 2.65kg'. This price includes an increase of 2.4 ¢/kg from A-154 which includes changes to feed and chick costs, operational and capital costs, and annual adjustments. It does not include Ontario modular loading or AI insurance costs.
 - The A-155 live minimum price is adjusted by 4.56¢/kg over the Ontario live price.
 - A positive chick price adjustment of 0.43 ¢/kg is due to the difference in chick price from Ontario's A-155 posted price of 80.38¢/chick versus Saskatchewan's A-155 posted price of 81.31 ¢/chick. This live price change is based on the Ontario cost of production formula a 1 cent change in chick price results in a 0.46638 cent change in live price.
- Processors will pay for all DOA's and the first 1.5% condemned parts (trim).
- Payment will be based on barn average weight.
- Contact your processor for weight specific pricing ranges.
