EFFECTIVE: April 14, 2019 (A-156 Production Cycle)

MINIMUM PRICE: \$1.5846/KG (live)

- The live minimum price for A-156 is a 1.53 ¢/kg decrease from the A-155 live minimum price of \$1.5999/kg (live). The change in price is based on:
 - The Ontario posted minimum live price of \$1.539/kg for weight category 'Over 2.45kg to 2.65kg'. This price includes a decrease of 1.0 ¢/kg from A-155 due to changes in feed and chick costs. It does not include Ontario modular loading or AI insurance costs.
 - The A-156 live minimum price is adjusted by 4.56¢/kg over the Ontario live price.
 - The chick price adjustment does not apply for this period, due to a higher Ontario chick price of 81.00¢/chick versus Saskatchewan's price of 80.66 ¢/chick.
- Processors will pay for all DOA's and the first 1.5% condemned parts (trim).
- Payment will be based on barn average weight.
- Contact your processor for weight specific pricing ranges.

NOTE:

- Growers, please pay close attention to your agreed upon weights.
- If you have any questions regarding the above information please do not hesitate to call the board office.
- Included in live price are catching costs of minimum \$0.035 per kilogram, which are charged back to the producer by the processor.
