EFFECTIVE: June 9, 2019 (A-157 Production Cycle)

MINIMUM PRICE: \$1.5846/KG (live)

- The live minimum price for A-157 is no change from the A-156 live minimum price of \$1.5846/kg (live). The price is based on:
 - The Ontario posted minimum live price of \$1.529/kg for weight category 'Over 2.45kg to 2.65kg'. This price includes a decrease of 1.0 ¢/kg from A-156 due to changes in feed and chick costs. It does not include Ontario modular loading or AI insurance costs.
 - The A-157 live minimum price is adjusted by 5.56¢/kg over the Ontario live price. This is a 1.00 ¢/kg increase over the previous cycle.
- Processors will pay for all DOA's and the first 1.5% condemned parts (trim).
- Payment will be based on barn average weight.
- Contact your processor for weight specific pricing ranges.

NOTE:

- Growers, please pay close attention to your agreed upon weights.
- If you have any questions regarding the above information please do not hesitate to call the board office.
- Included in live price are catching costs of minimum \$0.035 per kilogram, which are charged back to the producer by the processor.
