**EFFECTIVE:** September 29, 2019 (A-159 Production Cycle)

**A-159**  
**MINIMUM PRICE: \$1.6506/KG (live)**

- The live minimum price for A-159 is a 2.0¢/kg increase from the A-158 live minimum price of \$1.6306/kg (live). The price is based on:
  - The Ontario posted minimum live price of \$1.595/kg for weight category 'Over 2.45kg to 2.65kg'. This price includes an increase of 2.0¢/kg from A-158 due to changes in feed and chick costs. It does not include Ontario modular loading or AI insurance costs.
  - The A-159 live minimum price is adjusted by 5.56¢/kg over the Ontario live price.
  - The chick price adjustment does not apply for this period.
- Processors will pay for all DOA's and the first 1.5% condemned parts (trim).
- Payment will be based on barn average weight.
- Contact your processor for weight specific pricing ranges.

**NOTE:**

- Growers, please pay close attention to your agreed upon weights.
- If you have any questions regarding the above information please do not hesitate to call the board office.
- Included in live price are catching costs of minimum \$0.035 per kilogram, which are charged back to the producer by the processor.
